



## **Important Handover Information – The Alpha Bed / Beta Bed Kit**

Please read the following information carefully before using your wall bed and retain it for future reference.

### **Safety Before Use**

- It is the consumer's responsibility to ensure that anyone using the wall bed has been shown how to operate it safely before use.
- We recommend that only adults operate the wall bed. Failure to use the bed correctly may result in injury or damage to the product.
- Due to the risk of entrapment, children must not play on or around the bed in either the sleeping or stored position.
- It is essential that the bed and cabinet are securely fixed to the wall using the correct fixings.
- There is a risk of injury or death if the wall bed and/or cabinet are not correctly secured.
- Do not attempt to pull the bed down into the horizontal position unless it has been properly fixed to the wall.
- All fixings should be checked regularly.
- It is the fitter's responsibility to ensure that the correct fixings are used for the specific wall type. The fixings provided may not be suitable for every wall type.

### **Using The Bed**

- Always keep a hand on the bed frame when raising or lowering the bed.
- Do not allow the bed to drop freely or slam open or shut.
- Ensure the black steel fold-over legs are folded over the mattress before closing the cabinet front panel. Failure to do so may result in damage.
- When the bed is in the down position, make sure the legs are securely positioned beneath the front panel before sitting or lying on the bed.
- If the legs are not correctly positioned, the bed will not have adequate support and this may result in damage or injury.
- Secure the bedding to the mattress using the strap provided before closing the cabinet.
- Ensure that no bedding is protruding, as this may cause damage to the mechanism.
- Secure the pillow beneath the strap where required.
- Do not remove the mattress while the bed is in the horizontal position unless the bed frame is being supported by another person.

## **Maintenance & Moving The Bed**

- The bed and cabinet should be checked regularly for signs of wear.
- If the bed is being relocated, do not remove any fixings until the bed is in the vertical position.
- Relocation should ideally be carried out by a qualified fitter.
- Spring-balanced mechanisms must not be adjusted except by a qualified fitter.
- As part of the deinstallation process, the springs must be removed first.
- Please ensure that the springs are kept well lubricated.
- If the mattress is replaced with a lighter or heavier model, the number of springs installed may need to be altered to maintain correct counterbalance of the bed.
