



Important Handover Information – Complete Solutions

Please read the following information carefully before using your wall bed and retain it for future reference.

Safety Before Use

- It is the consumer's responsibility to ensure that anyone using the wall bed has been shown how to operate it safely before use.
- We recommend that only adults operate the wall bed. Failure to use the bed correctly may result in injury or damage to the product.
- It is the customer's / fitter's responsibility to ensure that the wall the bed is fixed to is suitable.
- The fitter must ensure that the correct fixings are used for the specific wall type. The fixings supplied may not be suitable for every wall type.
- Hideaway Beds cannot accept responsibility for damage or injury caused by incorrect installation or misuse of the product.
- Due to the risk of entrapment, children must not play on or around the bed in either the sleeping or stored position.
- Where applicable, always ensure the bed is securely fixed to the wall before pulling it down for use.

Using The bed

- Always keep a hand on the bed frame when raising or lowering the bed.
- Do not allow the bed to drop freely or slam open or shut.
- Secure the bedding to the mattress using the strap provided before closing the bed into the cabinet.
- Make sure no bedding is protruding, as this could damage the mechanism.
- Secure pillows beneath the strap where applicable.
- Do not remove the mattress while the bed is in the horizontal position unless the bed frame is being supported by another person.

Maintenance & Moving The Bed

- Periodically inspect all mounting points and mechanical connections to ensure they remain secure and tight.
- If the mechanism begins to make noise during operation, ensure the connecting points are properly lubricated.
- If the bed needs to be relocated, do not remove any fixings until the bed is in the vertical position.
- Relocation should ideally be carried out by a qualified or competent fitter.
